CARE TIPS FOR YOUR NEW MOTH ORCHID:

1. Lighting

Indirect light: Place your moth orchid in an east facing window, or shaded south or west window.

2. Watering

Water thoroughly and let it become almost dry before watering again. Avoid using distilled or softened water.

3. Humidity + Temperature

Humidity should be between 50 and 80%. If necessary, set your orchid in a tray of pebbles with a shallow amount of water to help increase humidity. Temperatures should be between 70-80°F during the day, and drop no lower than 60°F at night.

4. Fertilization

If your moth orchid is in bark potting mix, use a high-nitrogen fertilizer twice a month. For all other potting media, a use a balanced fertilizer at half strength once a week.
